Workshop Description

Developmental Evaluation (DE) is an evaluative process for informing, supporting, and

facilitating adaptation and innovation of change initiatives, projects, and programs to changing

conditions in complex dynamic environments. DE now has a 20-year history of development

itself. The pandemic greatly increased applications of DE as both programs and evaluations had

to pivot dramatically and urgently. A new edition of Patton's Developmental Evaluation book

will be previewed during this session and will be the basis for new directions, methods, tools,

frameworks, and applications presented in this workshop.

Present and engage participants with how DE has developed over the last decade with examplars

of actual applications and new methods being used.
